## Thermopile Sensor OTP-638D2

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The OTP-638D2 is a thermopile sensor in classic TO-46 housing. The sensor is composed of 116 elements of thermocouple in series on a floating micro-membrane having an active area of diameter 545  $\mu$ m. The thermopile sensor provides nearly Johnson-noise-limited performance, which can be calculated by its ohmic series resistance. A thermistor with a lead connected to ground is also provided inside the TO package for ambient temperature reference.

- TO-46 metal housing
- Thermistor temperature reference included
- Low temperature coefficient of sensitivity
- Ideally suited for ear thermometers, miniature pyrometer.
